1. Is Sani Professional® Brand Foodservice Towel compostable?

Yes, Sani Professional Brand Foodservice Towel is compostable.

Sani Professional Brand Foodservice Towel passed all 3 industry standard testing methods for compostability.

- ii. ISO 17088 (International standard)

2. Is Sani Professional Brand Foodservice Towel made from sustainable materials?

- Yes, Sani Professional® Brand Foodservice Towel is made from sustainable materials. It is made from 100% viscose fibers. Viscose is made from wood pulp. Wood pulp is produced from trees specifically grown for wood pulp manufacturing.
- The Sani Professional Brand Foodservice Towel is sourced from companies that provide Certification of Registration regarding the sustainability of the wood pulp that is used in the manufacturing process.

3. How absorbent is the Sani Professional® Brand Foodservice Towel?

The Sani Professional® Brand Foodservice Towel absorbs up to 8 times its own weight* in spills, making it the most absorbent towel in its class.

4. Can I use Sani Professional Brand Foodservice Towel with quat based sanitizers?

Yes, Sani Professional® Brand Foodservice Towel is compatible and can be used with quat-based food contact surface sanitizers, as long as manufacturer instructions are followed in preparation of the quat-based sanitizer. The Sani Professional® Brand Foodservice Towel should be placed in a bucket/tray and properly saturated with prepared or ready-to-use quat based sanitizer to meet food code release guidelines.

5. How many times can I use one towel?

The Sani Professional® Brand Foodservice towel is extremely durable. It can be used up to 8 hours under normal usage conditions. Upon reviewing your specific manufacturer instructions, you may wash & reuse your Sani Professional® Brand Foodservice Towel after a cleaning cycle in your dishwasher and/or washing machine.
